



What is YFYFC?

Yorkshire Federation of Young Farmers' Clubs (YFYFC) was formed in 1974 following the amalgamation of the North and West ridings. YFYFC is now the largest YFC Federation in the country and consists of 45 clubs with over 1700 members.

YFYFC is a voluntary, self-funding, youth organisation covering North, South & West Yorkshire for people aged 10-26 years. Membership is open to anyone within the age range and members do not need to have an agricultural background to join.

Our aim is to provide a safe environment for our members in which they can have fun, make friends, learn new skills and achieve.

Yorkshire Federation of Young Farmers' Clubs is committed to keeping its members safe. It is important that members are protected while having a great time at all our YFC events and activities.

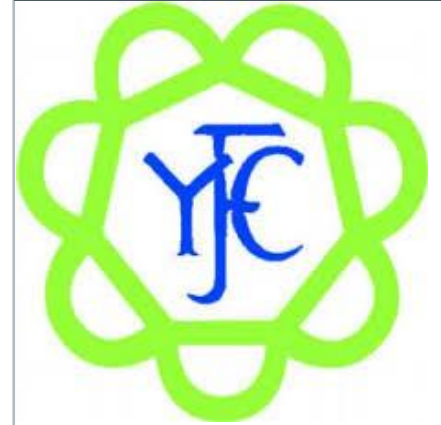
The federation provides guidance and support to our clubs about their duty of care as a youth organisation in areas such as safeguarding, health and safety and a wide range of issues relating to young people.

Club Information

Most clubs hold weekly meetings where members get together and socialise. Each club sets their own programme. This can include: talks, visits, social activities, swimming, ice skating. As well as the traditional YFC meetings of stock judging, public speaking and cookery.
