GENERAL RULES

1. ELIGIBILITY

- JUNIOR competitors must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.
- INTERMEDIATE competitors must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.
- OPEN competitors must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.
- All entrants must be a full member of a club affiliated to NFYFC.
- Competitors will be required to produce their current and signed membership card. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- Juniors will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions.
- If members cannot attend the Presentation of Awards, please ensure that someone is available to collect on your behalf.

2. REPRESENTATION

- Counties may enter one competitor per 600 members of part thereof in the Northern Area Final.
- Federations entering more than one team must designate them **A, B or C**.
- Once an entry has been made, competitors cannot be transferred from one team to another.
- The proportional representation will be calculated from the Membership Statistics as at 31 August 2019.
- NFYFC ruling on representing more than one County in a calendar year or event, is as follows: "That where a member represents a Club or county in an Area event, they may not represent a different Club or County in any other event in that same competition year (1 September to 31 August). However, a person who resigns from a Club and takes up membership of another, may represent that new Club or its County as from the date of joining, except that they may not represent more than one Club or County in successive rounds of the same competition which leads to a National Final"

3. AWARDS

- All competitions on the day will count towards The Earl of Derby trophy.
- Points will be awarded as follows: 1st place = 12 points, 2nd place = 11 points, 3rd place = 10 points, 4th place = 9 points and so on to 12th place. If a County is disqualified from a competition, they will be awarded 1 point. If a county does not enter a particular competition, they will be awarded 0 points, however if they enter and fail to turn up they will be awarded -1 points.
- The team scoring the highest overall points will win The Earl of Derby trophy.
- The team scoring the highest points in Stock judging will win The Barclays Bank trophy.
- The team scoring the highest points in all other competitions (**excluding** NFYFC and all judging), will win the East Riding Shield.
- Certificates will be awarded to teams placed 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each event. Individual members of a team will receive a certificate.

4. TIMETABLE

Competitors may compete in more than one competition where the timetable allows them to do so. The timetable is final and will not be changed to accommodate any individual or team. Any competitor not reporting at the time stated, or being unable to compete when we require, will be eliminated, and therefore awarded -1 points. The organisers will make every effort to keep competitions running to the times stated however cannot be responsible if due to unforeseen circumstances they are unable to do so.

5. JUDGES/STEWARDS DECISIONS

- The judges' decision is final. Written notification of intention to lodge a complaint or to dispute the result must be received half an hour prior to the presentation of awards and should be accompanied by a £10 cash deposit. The £10 deposit shall be returned to the individual complaining in the event that the complaint is upheld. If the complaint is not upheld the fee shall be forfeited. Please note that complaints will **ONLY** be accepted from a competing member or team captain
- Unacceptable behaviour by competitors or supporters, which adversely affects other competitors, will be penalised.
- Abusive behaviour towards Judges and Stewards will, in continual and extreme cases, lead to disqualification.
- Members are reminded that in taking part in the competitions, material of a questionable nature will be penalised. Members are to bear in mind that they are performing to a family audience.
- Northern Area YFC reserve the right to amend or cancel any of the Rules.
- Northern Area YFC will not be responsible for any expenses incurred by competitors nor for arrangements for accommodation.

8. HEALTH & SAFETY & CHILD PROTECTION

- All competitions at Northern Area Field Day will be Risk Assessed to ensure the safety of competitors, supporters and guests.

Competitors should be aware of relevant Health & Safety issues and thus follow the instructions of judges and stewards at all times.

- Northern Area will not accept responsibility for any members under the age of 18 who have not produced their Parental Consent Form on the day of the Northern Area Field Day. If the relevant forms are not available at the Northern Area Field Day then, in accordance with the Federation's Child Protection Policy, members will not be allowed to take part.

9. HELPING MEMBERS WITH LEARNING DISABILITIES

Northern Area supports NFYFC in their effort to seek the inclusion of the full membership in all its endeavours. Should a member require assistance to compete at Northern Area Field Day due to disability (learning/physical), every effort shall be made to ensure inclusion of the individual with dignity, respect and confidentiality. Northern Area requests prior knowledge of assistance required in order to maximise the benefit to the individual.

10. INSURANCE

The cover provided by the NFYFC Insurance Scheme will apply to all Clubs and members participating in Competitions. Each Club has been supplied with full details, and further information is readily available from the Insurance Department, NFU Mutual Insurance Society Limited.

Northern Area Field Day Competitions

Class 1 - Northern Area's Got Talent

1. VENUE

1.1. The final will be held virtually on Saturday 26th June 2021

2. REPRESENTATION

2.1. Counties may enter one team per 600 members or part thereof.

3. Eligibility

- a. The team will consist of between two and six competitors, all of whom must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020 and full members of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.
- b. All competitors are required to send a photo of their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with their entry. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- c. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions
- d. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.
- e. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

Procedure

- 4.1. Teams are required to record themselves performing a specific talent. This could be Musical, Singing, Instrumental, Dancing or a Comedy Sketch for example. Props are permitted in videos.
- 4.2. To adhere to Government Guidelines, entries should be from the same household/support bubble. Where entries are not from the same household or bubble, social distancing must be maintained – if current Government Guidelines allow.
- 4.3. Each performance should begin with an introduction – the Counties Northern Area Card (NAFD 2021 and County number) and which team they are representing (A, B or C) and a brief description of the talent.
- 4.4. Teams are reminded that material considered to be distasteful or inappropriate may result in the loss of marks. All material to be suitable for a family audience. The use of foul language will be penalised with a deduction of marks. All music used must be a Radio Edit – i.e. suitable and passed for radio broadcast to family (pre watershed) audiences.
- 4.5. **Video clips to be sent into Northern Area no later than Friday 18th June 2021 by the County Office alongside an entry form documenting membership details of all performers.** Files can be sent via email or a file sharing method such as WeTransfer (wetransfer.com)
- 4.6. Teams to provide a completed PRS form documenting any music used in their performance. PRS forms can be downloaded from the Competitions section of the NFYFC website. This form should be sent to NFYFC, Competitions Department with the team's entry form

5. Timing

- 5.1. The team will have a minimum of 3 minutes and a maximum of 7 minutes. This time limit includes setting up and tidying up.
- 5.2. Time faults will be imposed for timings above or below the time limits at a rate of 2 marks deducted per 15 seconds or part thereof.

Class 2 - Cube Exhibit

1. VENUE

1.1. The final will be held virtually on Saturday 26th June 2021

2. REPRESENTATION

2.1. Counties may enter one exhibit per 600 members or part thereof.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1. Competitors to be 27 years of age or under on 1 September 2019 and a full member of a Club affiliated to the NFYFC.
- 3.2. All competitors are required to send a photo of their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with their entry. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- 3.3. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions
- 3.4. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.
- 3.5. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

4. Procedure

- 4.1. Competitors will be required to produce an exhibit to the theme "National Sporting Event". 5 craft items are to be judged:
- 4.1.1. Craft 1 - Floral Art (Any item using cut flowers and accessories in a suitable container)
- 4.1.2. Craft 2 – Cookery/Baking (This will be judged on appearance).
- 4.1.3. Craft 3 – Textile Handicraft (Patchwork Quilt)
- 4.1.4. Craft 4 – Recycled Handicraft (A piece of sports equipment made from recycled plastic material)
- 4.1.5. Craft 5 – Art Handicraft (Collage of photography).
- 4.1.6. The five (5) crafts need to be clearly marked 1-5 together with the heading that the craft comes under. For example, 1- Floral Art, 2 – Cookery, 3- Textile Handicraft, 4- Recycled Handicraft, 5- Art Handicraft.
- 4.1.7. Each whole Exhibit to have a **MAXIMUM WIDTH** of 1 metre, a **MAXIMUM DEPTH** of 1 metre and **MAXIMUM HEIGHT** of 1 metre. **Any exhibit exceeding the maximum measurements will be disqualified.** The measurement will be from the outside edges of the external walls of the exhibit. Any accessories or drapes used on the outside of the external walls of the cube will be included in the overall measurement of the exhibit. The external walls will be taken into account for the attractiveness of the exhibit marks and so should be covered to complement the overall exhibit. The exhibit must have 3 walls and be displayed straight on.
- 4.1.8. **A total of 9 photos are required to be sent into Northern Area via email no later than Friday 18th June 2021 by the County Office. A photo of each individual craft, 1 photo of the overall exhibit that includes the Counties Northern Area Card (NAFD 2021 and County number) and which team they are representing (A, B or C), 3 further photos that clearly show the width, depth and height of the exhibit (tape measure must be included)**

5. Timing

5.1. All items should be newly made in the 12 months up to June 2021 and must be the unaided work of the named competitor.

Classes 3,4,& 5 – Beef Stock Judging

1. VENUE

1.1. The final will be held virtually on Saturday 26th June 2021

2. REPRESENTATION

2.1. Counties may enter one competitor per 600 members or part thereof.

3. ELIGIBILITY

3.1. **Junior:** The competitor must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Intermediate: The competitor must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

Senior: The competitor must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

1.2. All competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with suitable ID. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

1.3. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions

1.4. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.

1.5. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

4. PROCEDURE

4.1. Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on a ring of 4 store cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. All competitors must provide and wear a white coat, which will be worn during the period of competition. Throughout the competition, competitors must not communicate directly or indirectly with any person other than Judges and Stewards under penalty of disqualification. Members of the public will not be allowed in the judging area.

4.2. Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes to watch videos and stills of the 4 cattle. After 15 minutes, each competitor will be required to submit their placings via a Google Form. Each competitor will then be required to log in to a separate Judges Zoom meeting to give their reasons (Timings to be given on the day)

5. TIMING

5.1. Competitors will be allowed 15 minutes for judging of the stock and each competitor will be allowed up to 2 minutes for stating their reasons. Competitors exceeding this time limit will incur penalties at the rate of 2 marks for each 15 seconds or part thereof. The marks will be deducted from their total score.

3.1. **Junior:** The competitor must be 17 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

3.2. **Intermediate:** The competitor must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

3.3. **Senior:** The competitor must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.

3.4. All competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with suitable ID. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.

3.5. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions

3.6. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.

3.7. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

4. PROCEDURE

- 4.1. Competitors will be required to judge and give reasons on a ring of 4 dairy cattle. Animals will be designated A, B, X & Y. Each competitor will then be required to log in to a separate Judges Zoom meeting to give their reasons (Timings to be given on the day)

- 3.2. All competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with suitable ID. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- 3.3. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions
- 3.4. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.
- 3.5. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

- b. All competitors are required to send a photo of their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with their entry. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- c. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions
- d. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.
- e. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

4. Procedure

- a. Competitors to make Japanese Kimono that would be suitable to be worn for the Opening Ceremony of a National Sporting Event. It will then be worn by the competitor in a fashion show. Photos must also be taken of the template the outfit was produced from.
- b. **A video of the outfit being worn and a maximum of 6 photos of the outfit in a picture collage are required to be sent into Northern Area via email no later than Friday 18th June 2021 by the County Office. A photo of the template the outfit was made from is also required. The photos should also include the Counties Northern Area Card (NAFD 2021 and County number) and which team they are representing (A, B or C).**

5. Timing

- a. All items should be newly made in the 12 months up to June 2021 and must be the unaided work of the named competitor.

Class 13 & 14 - Floral Art

1. VENUE

- 1.1. The final will be held virtually on Saturday 26th June 2021.

2. REPRESENTATION

- 2.1. Counties may enter one exhibit per 600 members or part thereof.

3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1. The competitors must be 27 years of age or under on 1st September 2020.
- 3.2. All competitors are required *in person* to produce on the day their own current, **signed** NFYFC membership card with suitable ID. Failure to do so will result in a £5 fine.
- 3.3. U18's will be required to produce their signed parental approval form for all competitions
- 3.4. All competitors 18 and over are required to provide an extra form of ID such as a Passport/Driving Licence etc.
- 3.5. **All substitutes must have been eligible to compete in the County Final.**

4. PROCEDURE

- 4.1. **Male:** To make a hand tied bouquet of flowers for the winner of a National Sporting Event. To be viewed from all angles. Maximum space allowed: 50cm wide x 50cm deep x unlimited height.
- 4.2. **Female:** To make a hand tied bouquet of flowers for the winner of a National Sporting Event. To be judged from the front. Maximum space allowed: 75cm wide x 60cm deep x unlimited height.

- 4.3. Pre-cut and pre-soaked oasis are allowed. No pre-cut flowers allowed. All the work of the arranging and assembling of materials must be carried out during the competition. Competitors must wear white coats.
- 4.4. **Competitors will be required to log in to a Zoom meeting to complete the arrangement live. Once completed, competitors will be required to send in 4 photos – one of the overall arrangement that includes the Counties Northern Area Card (NAFD 2021 and County Number) and which team they are representing (A, B or C), 3 further photos that clearly show the width, depth and height of the exhibit (tape measure must be included). These photos must be sent within 30 minutes of completion.**
5. **TIMING**
- 5.1. Competitors will be allowed 1 hour for arranging with a further 10 minutes to check that the arrangement has not been disturbed during clearing up. Competitors will log in to a Zoom meeting to complete the arrangement live.
